This is all part of our three-year ENGAGE plan. We will conclude our ENGAGE Bristol sermon series on February 18. On February 25, we will begin a new series called *Ordinary Angels*.

We may not be angels sent from Heaven, but we can be ordinary people that God uses to help others in their time of need. The word angel in the Bible does often refer to celestial beings sent by God, but it can also refer to earthly people sent by God. Every day, we have the opportunity to be an ordinary angel to someone.

I hope you will join us at the theater and I also hope you will join us for a four-part Sermon Series beginning February 25 based on the theme of the movie (see series outline below). God bless you all and let's continue to ENGAGE the people of Bristol and spread the hope of Jesus, because we all know, *Hope Changes Everything!*
